



NewSpring Church Internship Program

Overview

The NewSpring Church Internship Program is designed to give participants ministry experience as well as a glimpse into the life of someone in ministry. Participants will gain valuable ministry experience while working alongside NewSpring staff members. Internship positions are available during the fall, spring, and summer semesters.

Application Process

Qualifications:

- Completed High School
- 18 to 25 years old
- Exemplifies a life of a growing Christ Follower
- Fully supportive of the vision of NewSpring Church

All potential participants will be required to fill out the Internship Program application. A select group of applicants will be chosen for the interview process. After the interview process, applicants will be notified if they have been chosen for the Internship Program.

Schedule

During the spring, summer and fall semesters intern positions will require a maximum time commitment of 25 hours per week. Semester dates are tentative.

Summer 2010- Begins May 17, 2010 and ends August 8, 2010. Application deadline for the summer 2010 semester is March 15, 2010. Applicants will be interviewed and notified by April 19, 2010. The summer program is 12 weeks.

Fall 2010 - Begins August 23, 2010 and ends December 5, 2010. Application deadline for the fall 2009 semester is June 17, 2010. Applicants will be interviewed and notified by July 29, 2010. The fall program is 15 weeks.

Weekly Routine

The weekly routine will vary depending on the intern's ministry area and the needs of the specific internship area.

Additional FAQs

Do interns work on Sundays?

Most interns will have a role that will require them to work on Sundays. The department supervisors will determine the work hours for each intern position. Any hours worked on Sunday will be included in the total hours per week.

Is the internship paid?

Yes, interns are paid an hourly rate of \$10. However, if someone is earning college credit through the internship the guidelines set forth by the college or university in regards to compensation will be followed.

Will NewSpring help interns with housing?

Currently, the intern program is not designed to provide or assist interns with housing. All interns will be responsible for securing their own housing.
